**FINAL RESULT OF INVESTIGATOR GR.II ADVERTISED VIDE CAT. NO. NWR-5 OF  
ADVT. NO. SSC/NWR-3/2014 IN LABOUR BUREAU, CHANDIGARH**

Staff Selection Commission (NWR) advertised 40 (UR-24,SC-04,ST-02 & OBC-10), (one vacancy reserved for OH category) vacancies for the post of Investigator Gr.II in Labour Bureau, Chandigarh vide Cat. No. NWR-5 OF Advt. No. SSC/NWR-3/2014 on 18.10.2014.

After primary Scrutiny of 5383 received applications, a tentative rejection list prepared on the basis of EQ-I & EQ-II was placed on website for representation of the candidates against their rejection on 03.03.2015. It was found that most of the representations submitted by the candidates were against the rejection related to EQ-II (i.e. **Certificate/Diploma Course in Computer Operation or Software from a recognized Institution**). The copies of certificates submitted by applicants and their representations were not elaborate to confirm the eligibility of the candidates, rejection list placed on website on 03.03.2015 was cancelled by the Commission and a fresh tentative rejection list prepared in accordance with the consultation of the Labour Bureau, Chandigarh was placed on website on 30.01.2016 for representations of the candidates. It was again observed that the certificates and representations were not sufficient enough to decide eligibility as per EQ-II. It was therefore, decided to check the eligibility for EQ-II at the time of Document Verification and not to reject the applicants on the basis of EQ-II in initial stage. Candidates were shortlisted for Written Examination on the basis of percentage of marks in EQ-I as per standard procedure. Short listing criteria category wise for Written Examination was:-

UR: 60 % and above  
OBC: 60% and above  
SC: 60% and above  
ST: 55% and above

On the basis of the performance in Written Examination held on 23.07.2016, 128 candidates were called for Document Verification in accordance with the ratio of 1:3 for each vacancy in each category as per the following cut off marks:-

The Commission in consultation with the Labour Bureau, Chandigarh has finally decided that the candidates having EQ-I & EQ-II in the following manner are eligible for the post:

Essential Qualification -I :

Candidates who have studied any one subject out of 04 subjects (Statistics or Mathematics or Economics or Commerce) in Bachelor Degree fulfill EQ-I.



Essential Qualification -II :

- a) Candidates having Computer Certificate/Diploma Certificate in Computer Operation or Software issued by recognized Institution/Body like AICTE, UGC, NIELIT, Central/State Govt./Union Territory Administration, fulfill EQ-II.
- b) Candidates having any Degree or Higher Degree in Applied Fields of Computer/IT (including B.Tech with Computer Science/B.Sc.(Computer Science)/BCA/MCA) fulfill EQ-II.
- c) Candidates who have studied computer/IT in their degree but computer/IT is **not** the core area, need an additional Certificate/Diploma in Computer Operation or Software.

Based on above, the candidates have been selected in order of merit of Written Examination but some of the candidates have been selected provisionally subject to the verification of recognition of EQ-II by the Appointing Authority and if it is found that their certificates for EQ-II submitted at the time of Document Verification are not issued by recognised Institution/Body, their candidature shall be cancelled.

The result and the Select List are **purely provisional** and subject to the correction and modification due to any genuine reason. The result is further subject to outcome of O.A. No.060/00642/2016 filed in Hon'ble Central Administrative Tribunal, Chandigarh bench.
